(To be Read in the Camp and Filed)

- 1) It is with deep regret that I announce the suspension of the Camps listed below. Ample time has been given to the Camp and its Officers to send the required items to the Sec./Treas., Department of Pennsylvania. This did not occur, hence the suspension. During this suspension, transaction of any Camp business can not occur and any Brother that is part of that camp is not in good standing within our order until the suspension is lifted by the Department Commander

If the suspended Camps do not resolve the issues at hand, I will ask the Commander in Chief to revoke the charters and the Camp will close. All monetary funds, records and Artifacts, etc. that were in possession of the Camp shall be turned over to the Department Of Pennsylvania. Brothers can then be transfered into Camp 300 "At Large" or another Camp within the Department if they so wish. All dues will have to be paid to the new Camp.

If the Camps resolve the issues, the Department Commander can lift the suspension and all restrictions will be lifted.
