



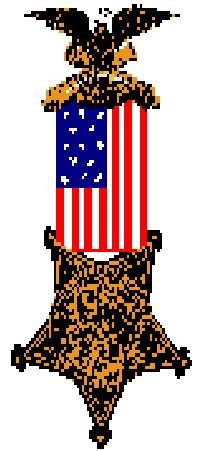

It has come to my attention that my email has been used as part of a phishing scam which is designed to appear as a request from me to purchase gift cards to be donated to veterans in hospice care. From the research I've done, there appear to be several variations of this type of scam traveling around the internet. The text of the one that is impersonating me is as follows:

I'm glad you like to help, I'll write out specific details.

I need you to please make arrangements for purchase of 5 (five) cards with a value of \$100.00 apiece for a total of \$500.00 of any Prepaid gift cards, eBay gift cards or Walmart gift card, for donation to Veterans at Hospice Care and welfare. Cards are available at most Macy's Stores, Drug Stores or other Convenience Stores.

All you need to do when you have the cards, kindly open, Scratch back of each gift vouchers, take a snapshot of each card PIN & email to Veterans Hospice Palliative Care veterans_care@ts-kc.com Note: Donated by "Pennsylvania Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War" I will be liable for payment will a check be fine for refund? Can you handle this for me today? I'll be grateful if you can.
